

"Brutal but Beautiful" Exhibition

"Modern architecture is not a style, but an attitude."
Marcel Breuer

Set on a mountainside at an altitude of 1,600 metres, amidst the 265 km of runs that make up the Grand Massif ski area, Flaine surprises, fascinates and sometimes even perturbs due to its **Marcel Breuer-designed architecture**, which is as unexpected as it is remarkable.



In the early 1960s, **Eric and Sylvie Boissonnas**, who were passionate about modern art and the mountains, decided to embark on a large-scale project to develop winter sports by building infrastructures that combined **contemporary architecture with respect for the environment**.



Assisted by Marcel Breuer, master architect of the **"Bauhaus"** school, and known around the world for many of his accomplishments, along with a group of architects comprised of Gérard Chervaz, Laurent Chappis, Denys Pradelle and André Gaillard, the Boissonnas created Flaine.

A listed, urban, Bauhaus resort... Flaine is above all a **resort that is integrated into the mountains that surround it**, its designers having taken great care to respect the environment. Like Gaudi in Barcelona, Marcel Breuer made Flaine an **atypical prototype**, based on **urban planning, design and aesthetic choices**. Even today, whilst the concrete buildings may at first glance be arresting, they are quickly forgotten as they blend into the landscape. And whilst nothing was left to chance in terms of the resort, it was the same with the ski area: the layout of the runs and the installation of the ski lifts were entrusted to the expert hands of **Emile Allais**, a genuine French skiing legend! Thus, in December 1968, Flaine welcomed its first holidaymakers...

A pioneer in many fields, it has been at the forefront from the start. And, 55 years later, this **architectural gem** has not aged a bit. Its accessibility, "ski-in/ski-out" concept, car-free resort centre... are all attributes that are still attractive today.




PRESTIGIOUS HONORS:

- The "Le Flaine" hotel and the "Bételgeuse" building are **listed in the French Historical Monuments Survey** in 1991.
- The ecumenical chapel is **listed on French Historical Monuments** since December 2014.
- Marcel Breuer's Flaine was **awarded the "Architectural Heritage of the 20th century" label** by the Ministry of Culture in 2008.



Permanent Exhibits



> A free guided tour is given every week by Flaine's Art Centre to learn more about the resort's heritage (in season and by reservation only).

Adorned with numerous works of art by renowned artists, Flaine is like an open-air museum. In keeping with the resort's atypical architecture, these works can be admired all year round!

"Le Boqueteau des 7 arbres" JEAN DUBUFFET, 1988.

"Le Boqueteau des 7 arbres", painted in black and white, reprises the 'Hourloupe' style, creating a monumental work of art perched in the heart of Flaine Forum. They interact both with "real" nature, and the geometric architecture of Marcel Breuer, going by the names of "The Butterfly, the Bulb, the Great Lobed One, the Antennae, the Bent One, the Two-Dimensional-Opened Out Tree, and the Sun".

> Monumental sculpture in epoxy resin and polyurethane, on an iron frame. Height 9.2 metres. Gifted by the Scaler Foundation*.

"Trois hexagones" VICTOR VASARELY, 1973.

The "Trois hexagones", poised on the roof of the shopping centre and visible from all over the resort, are a tribute to the Bauhaus movement, using its code of primary colours.

The artist gives the impression that we are seeing cubes within cubes... formed from multiple squares, but only an illusion of depth created on a two-dimensional surface.

"Tête de Femme" PABLO PICASSO, 1991.

This sculpture represents an illusionist's take in colour, relief, and substance, of the effects created by Pablo Picasso's artistry

on his original piece "Tête de Femme". Located near the cable car and the Totem hotel, the sculpture can be seen from multiple different angles by skiers as they head off for the slopes from the Forum.

> Painted sculpture. Acrylic paint and varnish over hot polymerised composite panels set on honeycombs mounted on a metal shaft. Height: 12 metres. Gifted by the Scaler Foundation*.

"Fontaine de glace" CARL NESJAR, 1974.

The Ice Fountain was the first outdoor artwork in Flaine, marking the entrance to the resort at Flaine Forum. In winter, Carl Nesjar's metal sculpture is transformed by a snowy coat and majestic stalactites of translucent white ice.

"Fontaine de l'auditorium" POL BURY" 1986.

The spheres of the Auditorium fountain, moved by the water, stir in immutable and almost perpetual motion, while a curtain of water forms around the top of the bowl. They grace the hall of the auditorium, marking time like a pendulum...

THE GRAND MASSIF

The 4th largest interconnected ski area in France, the Grand Massif comprises 5 very different resorts boasting complementary qualities: **Flaine** with its daring style, family-friendly **Les Carroz**, traditional **Morillon**, **Samoëns** at the heart of nature, and the hidden gem of **Sixt-Fer-à-Cheval**.

With 265km of runs, the Grand Massif is perfect for all levels and disciplines, ranging from steep forest runs to beginner's areas, not forgetting fun and freeride zones! In a nutshell, the ski area has something for everyone, and is located just a stone's throw from Annecy and Geneva, with exceptional views of the Mont Blanc massif in the background.

Since 2016, the Grand Massif is the first ski resort in the world to bear the Green Globe certification; in recognition of the efforts made by companies and organisations committed to sustainable tourism. THE RESORT

Extending from 1,580 metres to 1,800 metres, **Flaine comprises four geological balconies**, that do not overlook each other. **Free shuttlebuses** connect these different areas, with **2 lifts running** between Flaine Forum and Flaine Forêt. **Flaine resort sectors: Flaine Front de neige** – 1,580 metres / **Flaine Forum** – 1,620 metres / **Flaine Forêt** – 1,750 metres and **Flaine Les Gérats** with the Hameau de Flaine comprising 80 Scandinavian-style chalets – 1,800 metres.



THE SKI AREA

With downhill skiing, freeride and freestyle following the mountain's natural contours, in Flaine, snowsports fans can soak up stunning views from the top of Grandes Platières, with Mont Blanc at their ski tips, as well as a huge variety of long, playful runs, renowned for always being well groomed. Flaine's ski area also **features 4 departure points from the resort centre**, ensuring easy access to the slopes in the morning! Whilst most runs offer an abundance of easy wide curves, some can be quite steep with narrow sections that require a good level of fitness and technique. In Flaine, every detail is important.

The runs bear rather original names... with greens referring to Alpine trees and plants, blues named after semi-precious stones, reds evoking the devil, and blacks, the surrounding mountain ranges and precious stones!

NORDIC SKI AREA

Set at an altitude of 1,844 metres, the Col de Pierre Carrée overlooks the Arve valley and the resort of Flaine. **The highest Nordic skiing area in the Alps, it also boasts the most snow cover**, and can be reached by free shuttlebus or on foot from the resort centre if you're feeling energetic. Overlooking the Hameau de Flaine and its 80 Scandinavian chalets, you'll experience a total change of scenery!

GREEN RUNS IN THE HEART OF THE RESORT FOR BEGINNERS

Beginners of all ages will find plenty to enjoy on areas dedicated specifically to them in the heart of the resort. **4 lifts**, including 3 magic carpets (Pré, Michalet and Bissac) and 1 gondola are available

FREE OF CHARGE for beginners to learn and improve. **3 dedicated sectors** have also been set up in the safe areas of Pré and Bissac, where skiers can learn at their own pace, before gradually progressing onto the other green runs via the Ballacha ski lift. This Bauhaus resort is the perfect place to find your ski legs!

THE CASCADES BLUE RUN THROUGH THE CALM OF A NATURE RESERVE

Accessible from the Grandes Platières cable car at the top of Flaine, **the Cascades blue run takes you on a wonderful journey right down into the Sixt-Fer-à-Cheval nature reserve.** From an altitude of 2,480 metres, down to 760 metres, it boasts **14 km of pure pleasure** as the ever-changing landscapes drift by, without needing to take a



single ski lift... The return journey is by free shuttlebus as far as Samoëns, with a skibus every

20 minutes, and then back onto the Grand Massif ski domain. Enjoy with family or friends, for unforgettable memories.

Allow approximately 3 hours for the round trip. Grand Massif skipass required.

SERPENTINE, THE IMPRESSIVE BLUE RUN ON LES PLATIÈRES

The sunny Serpentine run and its gently rolling terrain is ideal for long turns. Highly popular with skiers of all levels, it offers **a breath-taking panorama of the entire resort.** On the way down, nature lovers will want to keep an eye out for rare, **bearded vultures or chamois** enjoying the morning sun.

FAUST, THE RED RUN FOR EXPERIENCED SKIERS

The famous Faust is **THE red run for more advanced skiers** seeking thrills and a good physical workout. It starts gently enough,





little path bypassing the Tête Pelouse, and thus into this paradise. There, **a fabulous, ungroomed ski area awaits, perfect for freeriders and fans of steep slopes**, with over 800 metres of vertical drop. Its northern exposure makes it ideal territory for powder days, while its southern slopes are unrivalled in spring! Experienced skiers will love the challenge of this multi-faceted run, with a reputation to match.

And those to explore on touring skis, over marked routes, day and night...

THE GRANDS VANS CLIMB

Running alongside the slopes in a safe environment, this route is accessible during the day (from 9am to 4pm), and is reserved solely for uphill use. The descent takes place on the ski area.

- > **Departure:** bottom of the Lac ski lift (Flaine Vernant) at 1,740 m
- > **Arrival:** top of the Grands Vans chairlift at 2,204 m
- > 464 metre altitude height difference



only revealing its true character as it snakes further down the mountain. Starting at the top of Les Grandes Platières, with Mont Blanc appearing at the tips of your skis, the first turns are fast and easy. Then, as you gain confidence, the serious stuff starts; in the middle of the forest, two consecutive steep and narrow sections take you right back into the centre of the resort. As your thighs will testify, it's not only devilish by name!

THE COMBE DE GERS, THE HIDDEN BLACK RUN

Tucked away, the Gers valley keeps its secrets well-hidden, only revealing them to those who venture onto the

THE AUJON ASCENT

Open when the slopes close for the day, until 9pm, this route invites you to experience ski touring at sunset, or at night-time. Enjoy a magical moment in the peace and quiet of the domain as it prepares for the night ahead.

- > **Departure:** bottom of the Célestine run at 1,577 m
- > **Arrivée :** summit of the Aujon ski lift at 1,951 m
- > 374 metre altitude height difference

THE "AU FIL DE L'AUP" ITINERARY

Set in the middle of nature, this safe, marked itinerary goes around the edges of Flaine's ski area, so that ski tourers can enjoy a calm ascent, far from the busier resort runs.

- > **Arrival:** summit of the gondola of the Aup de Veran at 2,196 m

3-STAR TOTEM FRIENDLY HOTEL

Set in the heart of Flaine Forum, Le Totem is a **lively, welcoming place to stay, where the focus is firmly on shared experiences**. A vast reception area, set against the backdrop of raw concrete, as designed by Marcel Breuer, is softened by chestnut-oak furniture, with the eye drawn to colourful fabrics and ethic designs. **The fireplace in the lounge/bar is yet another concrete work of art** created by the Bauhaus *enfant terrible*, with a **second, Breuer-designed fireplace located in the loft**. In addition to its 96, sixties-style bedrooms, the hotel restaurant features different styles and themes (Alpine and Italian specialities, a "Healthy Corner" for fans of green living and vegan food, not forgetting slow-cooked dishes, kids meals, soups, snacks and an incredible breakfast buffet), a spa

5 majestic concrete fireplaces created by Marcel Breuer and his team take pride of place inside 4 of the resort's establishments. Pieces of art in their own right, with their abstract cubic and conical design, they exude the characteristics of veritable sculptures, with veining and black and white aggregate appearing in the bush hammered or rough concrete. Impressionists

Being in a resort doesn't only mean skiing; there are plenty of other adventures to be had, and discoveries to be made! For those who are not into skiing, or who would simply like to try something new, Flaine offers many "non-skiing" activities involving gliding on snow and ice, thrills, sport, and landscapes, as well as moments of peace and quiet, with something for everyone. Here's an overview of activities available this winter in Flaine without even stepping into a pair of skis!

SNOOC

Sitting low to the ground, with one foot on either side of the ski/skate, you stabilise the Snooc with your feet and steer it by turning your shoulders.

A sit-ski for a safe, fun, and easy activity for non-skiers! To try it out, simply download the smartphone app and pay by credit card to unlock a Snooc (same principle as for bikes and scooters in town). Once you've got your bike, head for the ski lifts (Grandes Platières cable car, Aup de Véran gondola or the magic carpets), and then enjoy the ride back down!

MOON BIKING

A genuine USO (Unidentified Sliding Object), the Moon Bike is the **first ultra-light, 100% electric snowbike**, combining the freedom of an e-bike with the power of a motorbike. With caterpillar tracks at the rear for increased lift, and a blade at the front for greater manoeuvrability, this ultra-modern piece of equipment is an environmentally-friendly alternative to the snowmobile. Thanks to its electric engine, it has a zero operational footprint, meaning you can **explore nature respectfully, and without making a sound**. Whether you prefer riding through the snow-covered forests to get away from the hustle and bustle, or hurtling down the slopes in search of new snowports thrills, anything's possible on a guided moon biking session.

ICE DRIVING

GRAVITY ZÉRO






